

Itinerary

Day 1: HANOI ARRIVAL

Upon arrival in Hanoi, you'll be warmly welcomed by our driver and transfer to hotel in Hanoi centre. Free time to relax after long flight.

Overnight: Hanoi

Day 2: HANOI - HALONG BAY TOUR

7h45 - 8h30: Pick you up at your hotel.

12h30: Arrive at Tuan Chau harbour and refresh at the Oasis Bay Lounge for about 20 minutes before boarding.

13h00: Transfer to cruise. Welcome drink, cruise briefing, safety instructions, and check-in cabins. Cruise and program commence.

13h30-14h30: Special lunch will be served on board while cruising and passing by Dog islet, Fighting Cock islet (symbol of Halong Bay), Hoa Cuong fishing village, Swan islet. After having lunch, the Oasis Bay will continue exploring the wonders of Halong bay. Anchoring the vessels at Frog Pond area.

15h30-17h00: Explore this beautiful area by kayaking through the majestic scenery or swimming in emerald coloured water.

17h15-18h45: Relax on the sundeck with a few cocktails complimented by a variety of tropical fruits and best local wines. Then attend a cooking demonstration with our Chef to learn one of the most popular cuisines in Vietnam: spring rolls, or refresh yourself in outdoor Jacuzzi.

19h00-20h00: Enjoy a specially gourmet dinner.

21h00-23h00: Evening Activities, relax at leisure: squid fishing

Day 3: HALONG BAY - HANOI

6h30: Wake up to a very special morning with an organized Tai Chi class among the peaceful surroundings of Halong.

7h00-7h30: Breakfast. Coffee & tea with assorted homemade pastries, fresh juices...

8h00-9h00: Visit Sung Sot Cave, hiking up and down 600 steps to the magnificent limestone formations of the most beautiful and biggest cave in Halong bay.

9h30 Check-out cabins and settle bills.

10h30: Lunch will be served while the Oasis Bay is cruising back to Tuan Chau harbor.

12h30-12h45: Shuttle bus pick guest up at Oasis Bay Lounge.

17h00-17h30: Arrive in Hanoi.

DAY 4: HANOI FREE DAY

You have this day for free to explore Hanoi city. You can wander along streets in Hanoi Old Quarter to see how's the local life going on with lots of vendors, busy Dong Xuan market, visit Hoan Kiem Lake where has Ngoc Son temple, Turtle tower...or get to small lane at Nguyen Huu Huan street to taste a cup of Egg coffee at Giang Coffee which is too famous.

Day 5: HANOI - FLIGHT TO HO CHI MINH CITY

Have breakfast at hotel, have free time till pick up for transfer to the airport and get domestic flight to Ho Chi minh city. Airport pick up and check in hotel.

Day 6: HO CHI MINH CITY - CU CHI TUNNEL TOUR

After breakfast, pick up for Cu Chi tour departure (08.15 - 08.30 Am)

Located 60km from HCMC, Cu Chi is now a popular spot for both Vietnamese & foreign tourists - the network of over 200km of tunnels became legendary when they played a vital role in the War. In their heyday, the tunnels were functioning underground cities including numerous trap doors, specially constructed living areas, storage facilities, weapons factories, field hospitals, command centers & kitchens.

Today, ducks and water buffalos happily co-exist in the rivers along the side of the road. However, the peaceful rural rice paddy scenery belies the area's violent history. Visitors will find it hard to imagine the destruction, damage & defoliation over this whole area, caused by bombing and mines. There is plenty of evidence of the fierce battle that took place here during the 1960s when Cu Chi was a "Free Target Zone".

Before entering the tunnels visitors can watch a short introductory video showing how the tunnels were constructed. You will spend the next hour exploring the tunnels. Afterwards, enjoy tea, cassava (guerrilla's food during the war). Return to Ho Chi Minh city and enjoy some free time in the afternoon.

Day 7: MEKONG DELTA TOUR and FLOATING MARKET

8: 00: Picking up from hotel/stay.

08:15: Starting drive to Cai Be. Short time to take photos at Tan An town over the flat rice fields.

10:30: Start the motorized boat to visit the Cai Be Floating market, experience how people exchanging goods, fruit and many other commodities on their vessels. Visitors then roam into the small villages to visit the orchard, fruit plantation. Keep cruising to Vinh Long through small canals to enjoy the charm of the Upper Mekong Delta. Visit some handmade family business products such as the coconut candy mill, the crispy rice popcorn.

Arrive in Binh Hoa Phuoc village the green pearl of Vinh Long town where you can indulge yourself into the nature.

Have lunch with fresh river food served in the heart of the garden. Enjoy the southern Vietnamese traditional folk music. Take a nice walk through the bonsai garden, in Vinh Long. Head home to Ho Chi Minh City.

18:30: Arrive in your hotel.

DAY 8: HCMC – PHNOM PENH

Pick up from the hotel to bus station, Bus starts at 7.00 am and drive to Moc Bai border gate to enter Cambodia (bus time 6 – 7 hours). You will get visa on arrival with the help of bus crew (on request) for you to pass Cambodia.

Day 9: PHNOM PENH - KILLING FIELDS CHOEUING EK - RUSSIAN MARKET

After breakfast, at 08.00 Visit the Tuol Sleng Prison Museum and the notorious 'Killing Fields' of Choeng Ek, which will give us a deep insight into the painful

bloody rule of the Khmer Rouge. Lunch at local restaurant. We will have time this afternoon to explore Psar Toul Tom Pong, also called the "Russian Market", where anything and everything is for sale.

Later this afternoon, we will take a one-hour boat cruise on the Mekong river.

Day 10: PHNOM PENH - SIEM REAP

Transfer by private car to take a bus to Siem Reap; time on bus will be 6 hours. Private pick up and check into hotel

Day 11: SIEM REAP – ANGKOR TEMPLES

08.00 After breakfast, proceed to Angkor Thom Area (Angkor Thom Temple South Gate, Bayon Temple, Baphuon Temple, Phimean Akas Temple, Elephants Terrace & Leper King Terrace, Royal Palace, Woman and Man Pond) Proceed to visit Ta-Prom Temple.

After lunch, continue your journey to Angkor Wat Temple - one of the seven greatest architectural wonders of the world, built in between the 9th - 13th century. Before you end the tour, make a visit to Bakheng Hill for its beautiful sunset.

Day 12: SIEM REAP DEPARTURE

After breakfast, free at leisure till the time for you to be transferred to the airport for your flight back home.
