DAY-WISE TOUR ITINERARY

DAY 01: ARRIVAL JOHANNESBURG

- Upon arrival at Johannesburg O.R Tambo International Airport, meet & greet by our representative.
- Private transfers from Airport to your Hotel in Johannesburg.
Johannesburg city of South Africa is a hub for culture, food and art. With its art galleries, museum, food trails and vibrant cafes, Johannesburg is evolving as a diverse city that caters every need of tourist. One can even discover a vast option for accommodation from the budget stay to backer hostels and a luxurious hotel stay during the Johannesburg city tour. The developing lifestyle is rapidly boosting up the essence of Johannesburg. The city of Johannesburg, known to be the home of Nelson Mandela has some of the best museums and historical site preserving the history of South Africa.
- Check-in & freshen up.
- Rest of the day is free at leisure.
- Overnight in Johannesburg.

DAY 02: JOHANNESBURG – HAZYVIEW

- Breakfast at the Hotel.
- Check-out & private transfers to your Lodge in Hazyview.
- Upon arrival, Check-in & freshen up.
- Proceed for a **Sunset Safari inside the Kruger National Park.**
A Sunset safari in the Kruger National Park is a wonderful experience, and no matter what is to be seen or found that night, the magic of the bush by starlight is truly unforgettable. When the gates of the world-renowned Kruger National Park close at nightfall, you enter the park in an open safari vehicle with the powerful spotlights switched on. Under the expert guidance of an experienced ranger, you will track the elusive nocturnal animals of the African bush. In the quiet of the darkness, you can expect a different safari experience from that of the daytime, and as they become aware of their surroundings they will see smaller, more elusive, shy and rare creatures, not usually seen during the day.
- Transfer back to your Lodge & have Dinner.
- Overnight in Hazyview.

DAY 03: FULL DAY KRUGER SAFARI

- Breakfast at the Lodge.
- Proceed for a **Full Day Game Drive inside Kruger National Park** - It has been said that even an hour in paradise is a rewarding experience and this can also be said to be true of Africa's greatest wildlife sanctuary, the Kruger Park. An hour is rewarding, but a whole day is a life-changing experience. For an authentic safari experience, our full day Kruger Park safari will give you an unbelievable overview of this iconic destination. Game viewing from open safari vehicles in the Kruger Park has to be one of the ultimate safari experiences in Africa, your knowledgeable guide will interpret the bush and give you a detailed explanation of the animal's behaviour. You start your day early with an exciting open vehicle game drive. During the course of the day, you will make a pit stop at a peaceful, scenic picnic spot or a Rest Camp where you can get something to eat before setting off to explore more of the Kruger National Park. Kruger National Park is well-known for its boundless opportunities to spot the famous African Big Five - Elephant, Leopard, Buffalo, Rhino and of course Lion. You will experience South Africa's natural beauty, capture boastful wildlife photographs and have amazing African wildlife encounters.
- Transfer back to your Lodge & have Dinner.
- Overnight in Hazyview.

DAY 04: HAZYVIEW – JOHANNESBURG – GEORGE – KNYSNA

- Breakfast at the Lodge.
- Check-out & private transfers to Johannesburg Airport.
- Board a flight for George. **(Airfare not Included – must book an evening flight after 4pm)**
- Upon arrival, private transfers to your Hotel in Knysna
- Check-in & freshen up.
- Rest of the evening is free at leisure.
- Overnight in Knysna

DAY 05: KNYSNA – TSITSIKAMMA NP – KNYSNA

- Breakfast at the Hotel.
- Proceed for a **full day trip to Tsitsikamma National Park**.
- Proceed to the **Storms River Suspension Bridge & the Storms River Mouth**
- This coastal area is the premier place along the Garden Route to experience the best of the great outdoors. It is the place to visit for outdoor activities, marine sightings, scuba diving, Kayaking and much more. There are numerous walks to discover in Tsitsikamma. The most popular short walk is the two-kilometre Storms River Mouth Trail, which leads to the iconic Storms River suspension bridge.
- Later proceed to the **Bloukrans Bridge** which is the world's highest bungee jumping bridge (218m) - The



most amazing experience of your life! That pretty much sums up why we are doing what we do. How we do that is by keeping everyone safe, treating everyone with respect and helping people have fun! We do all this with a long bungy cord attached to Africa's largest bridge. The view from Africa's highest bridge captures all the majesty and tranquility of the Bloukrans River valley. But there is nothing tranquil about throwing yourself more than 200 metres down towards the river below. Recognised as the 'highest bungee from a bridge' in the world, Bloukrans Bungee uses pendulum bungee technology to ensure the smoothest, most comfortable bungee jump possible. Jumpers are secured in a full-body harness combined with an ankle connection. If you want, you can pay directly & do the bungy or you can take a spectator ticket to go to the bridge and watch people jumping. **(at an additional cost)**

- Transfer back to Knysna in the evening
- Overnight in Knysna

DAY 06: KNYSNA – OUDTSHOORN – MOSSEL BAY

- Breakfast at the Hotel.
- Check out & Proceed for a **Guided Full Day Trip to Oudtshoorn.**
- Arrive at **Cango Caves** into the dark tunnels and shadowy chambers of this popular tourist cave wind through nearly four kilometers of dimly lit underground passages. Visitors can only explore Cango Caves on guided group tours, which are offered in two vastly different options. The standard tour takes travelers through easy-going portions of the caves, where sharply pointed stalactites and stalagmites aglow from spotlights make for impressive photos.
- Arrive at **Ostrich farm** for a fun and inter-active guided tour of a working farm where you will be able to get close and personal to these ancient birds. You can stand on ostrich eggs and feed them and learn how we farm. Afterwards, our professional guide takes your group by tractor & trailer on a 25-minute Ostrich "Game Drive" through Zimbabwe Blue Ostrich Camp. We drive through natural veld with 16 Zimbabwe Blue ostriches as if in the wild.
- Arrive at **Cango Wildlife Ranch** & take a guided tour through the award-winning grounds for a look at flying foxes, exotic birds, and water monitors. Cheetah land, an elevated catwalk that made this ranch famous, is also home to tigers, cheetahs and even a white lion. But despite the wide variety of animals here, Cango Wildlife Ranch is not a zoo. The popular attraction takes conservation and community education seriously, which means visitors see the wildlife that makes this country unique, and get a lesson in preserving it, too.
- Transfer to Mossel Bay in the evening.
- Check & relax.
- Overnight in Mossel Bay

DAY 07: MOSSEL BAY – CAPE TOWN

- Breakfast at the Hotel.
- Check-out and Private transfer to your accommodation in Cape Town.
Long, coastline, the lively aura and the cultural harmony portrays the City of **Cape Town**. Lying towards the southwest coast, the port city of South Africa is the legislative capital that was established as a



supply station for the Dutch East Indies. Tourism in Cape Town is widespread due to the long shores and the magnificent beaches that are the hub engaged with entertainment. Above all, what make the Cape Town tour so popular are the vineyards with the wine tram tours arranged with some delight activities as wine tasting, cheese tasting, day picnics and the collection of best authentic wines of South Africa. The Cape Town city is ideally located to connect you with the famous adjoining attractions of South Africa.

- Upon arrival, Check-in to your Hotel and freshen up.
- The rest of the day is at Leisure.
- Overnight in Cape Town.

DAY 08: CAPE TOWN CITY TOUR

- Breakfast at the Hotel.
- Pick up from your hotel for a **Private Guided Cape Town City tour & Table Mountain Tour** - This morning you will be picked up from your hotel for a half-day Cape Town City tour. No visit to Cape Town is complete without a tour of the "Mother City". Sense the depth of history as you drive past Parliament Buildings, City Hall and the Slave Lodge before stopping for a short visit of the Castle of Good Hope (optional), originally built as a maritime replenishment station and now the oldest surviving colonial building in South Africa! Alternatively, we walk around the Grand Parade square which has its own historical significance. We hear of the brief history of District Six en-route to a visit at the Company Gardens where we walk through the landscaped gardens. Learn more about the history of the Bo-Kaap and its people as we move up the cobblestoned hills to the Malay Quarter, and marvel at the ice-cream colours of the quaint Bo-Kaap homes. Trace the moves of a professional diamond cutter as he creates every girl's dream stone with a visit to a diamond cutting factory. After learning more about the history of diamonds and gold in South Africa, we drive past the V&A Waterfront, Cape Town Stadium, Sea Point, Clifton and Camps Bay.
- We then make our way to Table Mountain where you will experience the revolving cable car ride to go up to the Table Mountain for a bird's-eye views of Cape Town and Peninsula from the top of the iconic **Table Mountain (weather dependent)**. You can wander across well marked paths to see views from all sides of the plateau. On a clear day it is even possible to see Robben Island, where Nelson Mandela was confined, on one side and Cape Point on the other.
- Proceed to **Groot Constantia for Wine Tasting**.
- Transfer back to your Hotel.
- Overnight in Cape Town.

DAY 09: FULL DAY CAPE POINT TOUR

- Breakfast at the Hotel.
- Pick up from your hotel for a **Private Guided Full Day Cape Point Tour** (also known as Cape Peninsula tour) - After Pick up from your Hotel, we will make our way through Mouille Point, Three Anchor Bay, Sea Point, Bantry Bay, Clifton and then stopping at Maidens Cove for some photo opportunities. We continue on through Camps Bay, then on to Hout Bay where you will do join a boat trip to the **Seal Island** (weather permitting) to witness the thousands of seals who inhabit it. Once we depart from Hout Bay, we will make



our way onto Chapmans Peak Drive, one of the world's most spectacular coastal drives with the views that will take your breath away, we will stop for a few minutes here.

- We now continue our journey towards the **Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve** and Cape Point which is set at the southernmost tip of Africa where the Atlantic Ocean and the Indian Ocean meet. You can expect to witness the dramatic clash of the seas from the view point where you will arrive by using a **Funicular Ride (Two way Tickets)**.
- We will then continue **Boulders Beach** which is a home to a growing colony of the protected **African penguins**. You can get your fix of cuteness as you walk alongside these penguins as they waddle their way around, lazing about in the sun or diving deep for the catch of the day. Then, meander into the afternoon, as the Atlantic coastline hugs cloud-capped mountains at the seaside town of Muizenberg where you will spot the famous colourful huts surrounded by Rocky Mountains. Stop for lunch here (at your own expense). Keep your eyes on the ocean as we drive back along this beach route to reach Cape Town by evening.
- Transfer back to your Hotel & relax.
- Overnight in Cape Town.

DAY 10: CAPE TOWN DEPARTURE

- This day of your Cape Town tour is a day at rest. **(No Services included)**
- Have a scrumptious breakfast at the hotel and loosen up. Enjoy spending the day at leisure in Cape Town as it allows you to either relax inside your hotel room, or go out and explore the city.
- You can also opt for some exciting activities as well which are not included in the package and can incur extra charges like Skydiving, Cape sidecar tour, Harley Davidson tour, Paragliding, Abseiling, Robben Island Tour, Visit to Two Ocean Aquarium, Hot Air Ballooning, Helicopter ride, Shark Cage Diving, Whale Watching, Wine Tram Tour, etc.
- Overnight in Cape Town.
